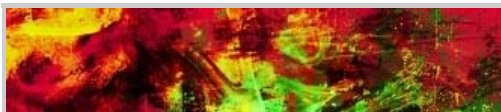

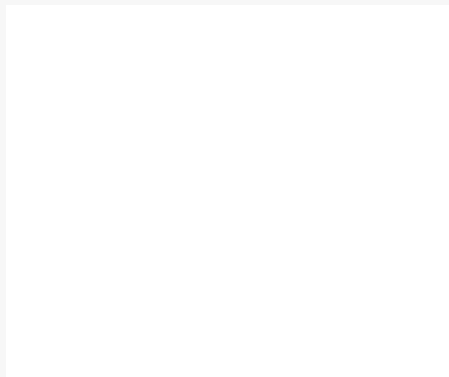

Custom HD2 wallpapers

In this tutorial you will teach you how to how to create a custom wallpaper for your HTC HD2 phone. Its very simple to do, nothing complicated about any one new to this device will be able to follow and duplicate my results.



Open Photoshop using the settings shown below. This is the default image size for the hd2.

Preset: HTC HD2

Size: [dropdown]

Width: 480 pixels

Height: 800 pixels

Resolution: 300 pixels/inch

Color Mode: RGB Color 16 bit

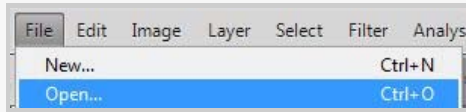
Background Contents: Transparent

Advanced

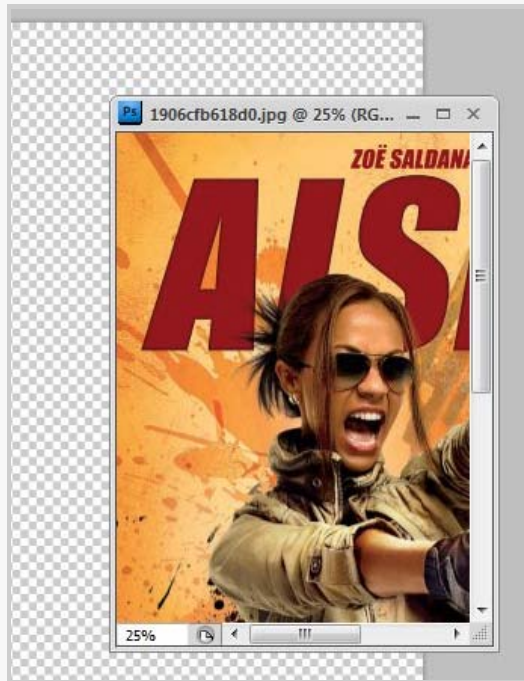
Color Profile: sRGB IEC61966-2.1

Pixel Aspect Ratio: Square Pixels

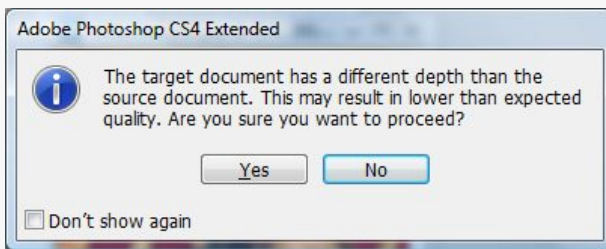
Click ok, this will open the work window. Click on **File > Open**



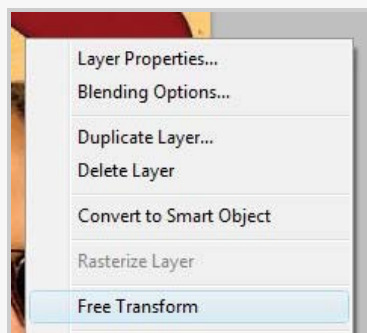
Browse to the image you want to use as your wallpaper.



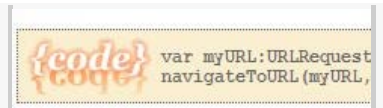
Drag your image over the the work area, you will get a warning message.



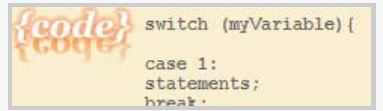
Click yes on the message. Now using the **Chop Tool** right click on your image



and select **Free Transform** and agjust your picture to fit the work area. Click on **Maintain Aspect Ratio**.

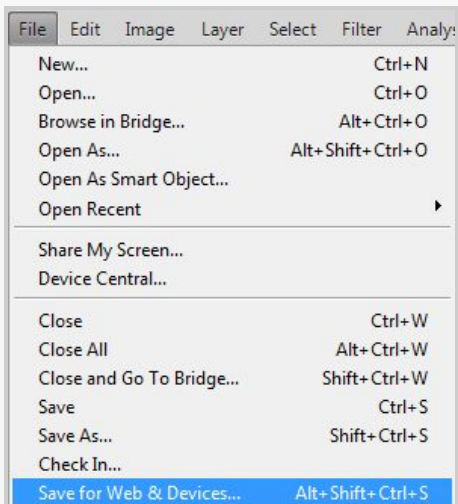
Start **Adjusting** the vertical scale.



Below is he final result.

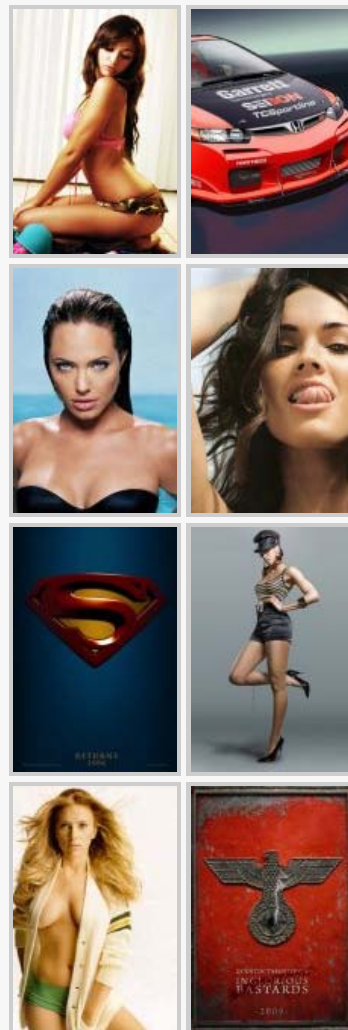


Now we need to export the image we just created. Click on **File > Save** for web.

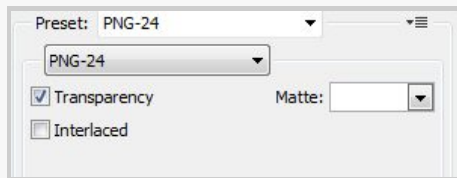


Save your image using the settings below.

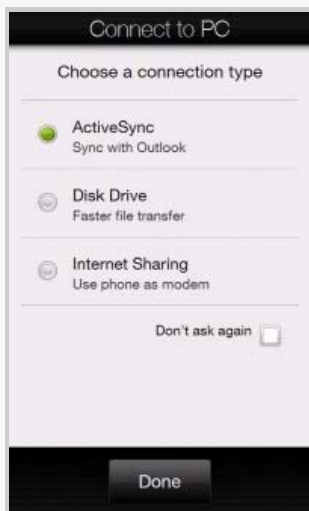

Using the USB cable connect the phone to the computer. With the cable connected Select ActiveSync



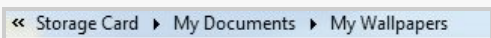
Open MyComputer and select your device.



I recommend putting the wallpaper on a storage card if you have one. After opening the HD2 you will see two folder if you have a storage card.



Open the storage card and browse to the folder shown below.



If you do not have the My Documents or My Wallpapers folder create it. The wallpapers folder is inside My

document. Place your wallpaper you created and saved in the wallpaper folder.



Click on **Start** located at the top of the main screen.



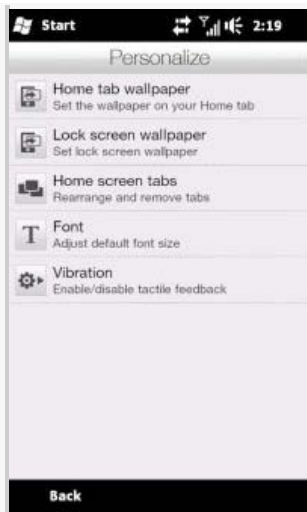
Click on **Settings**



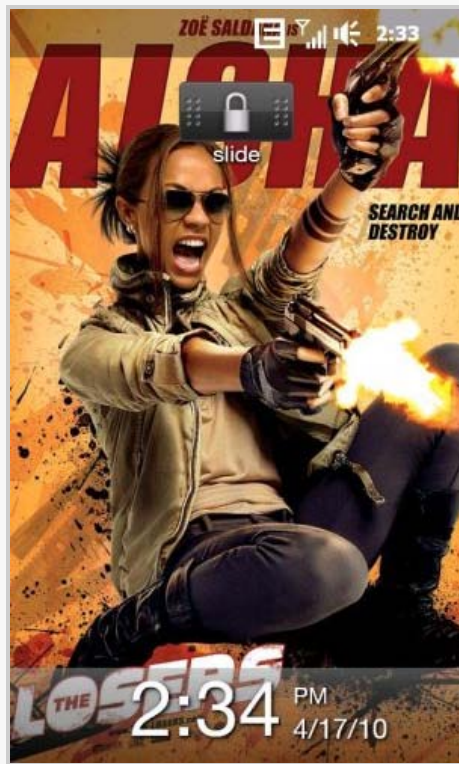
Select **Personalize**



Select **Lock Screen Wallpaper**



Select Albums and All. Here you will see the image you created. Click on it and lock your phone to see the background.
